Process for Interstate Travel



The process for flying puppies is extremely easy and something we have done many times before.

The first worry for most people is 'Will our puppy be okay?' and the answer is Yes!

All of our puppies are crate trained from an early age so being put in a crate and on a flight is a fine experience for them. The staff that take care of pets boarding and getting off the plane are wonderful and truely care for all the animals as well so you can rest assured they are in great hands.

Puppies between the ages of 8-12 weeks require a fit to fly certificate which we will organise with our vet prior to them travelling.

Tasmania is the only state that requires vaccination and worming documentation, which again we organise and ensure this paperwork is with your puppy when they travel.

All of our puppies go home with complementary pet insurance which we set up at midnight on the day of travel.

Flight costs vary from state to state however we have listed an approximate cost for each state on the next page.

Drop off information



We live 1.5 hours from Sydney Airport, and we personally transport every puppy to the airport ourselves. We never use third-party services to drop them off — your puppy is in trusted hands the whole way.

Before departure, we:

- Complete all airline paperwork and pre-flight requirements
- Ensure your puppy is well-settled, fed and toileted prior to travel
- Use IATA-approved airline crates

We stay at the airport until your puppy is safely checked in and on their way to you.

Your puppy will travel in an airline-approved pet crate designed for comfort and ventilation.

What's inside the crate:

- A blanket or newspaper (if puppies have a toilet accident the blanket will be replaced with newspaper)
- NO food, treats or water bowls (airport safety regulations)

Pick up information



Once your puppy arrives at your destination airport: You'll need:

- Photo ID
- Leash and secure collar or harness
- Water and a small bowl for hydration
- Space for their crate in the car

⚠ IMPORTANT: Be cautious as puppies may be disoriented or stressed from the loud sounds of the airport.

Do not open the crate until your puppy is in a secure area or inside your vehicle. Some pups may bolt or panic in unfamiliar settings, so safety is key during this moment.

DO NOT put puppies until 12 weeks on the ground as they are not fully vaccinated yet.

To avoid loss or damage in transit, we post your full Puppy Folder separately.

It includes:

- Vaccination records
- Microchip information
- Diet and care instructions
- Training and socialisation tips
- Pedigree paperwork
